This building **WILL NOT** be used for high-piled combustible storage, as defined in Chapter 23 of the California Fire Code. Stock pile heights will not exceed 12 feet in height for closely packed piles, shelves on racks or pallets.

-AND/OR-

Stock pile heights of highly combustible or flammable materials such as rubber tires, Group A plastics, flammable liquids, idle pallets and similar commodities will not exceed 6 feet in height.

This building **WILL** be used for high-piled combustible storage and will conform to the requirements of Chapter 23 of the California Fire Code.
