- A. **Resource Center Update**

- Director Acosta announced that all the computers and phone lines have been installed in the Resource Center.

- B. **Street Outreach - Artria Lewis**

- Outreach training/interacting with youth is going well and continues at JLHS for the staff. They have met with the JLHS School Principal and staff about the school activities. They are also training at Conley.

- There is a new volunteer with the Outreach Program that may possibly be a potential new hire.

- The staff has received their “Outreach” coats with logos and the Union City patch.

- C. **Youth Employment – Fabiola Camarillo**

- Fabiola Camarillo is looking for a location for a computer lab for youth to look for jobs and send their resumes and job applications. She is also still contacting with agencies about employing at risk youth.

- D. **Case Management – Sergio Abundis**

- Sergio Abundis handed out and discussed the “2008 Cal GRIP Projects Performance Data” report. He is accepting referrals from JLHS and Conley. The Outreach staff and Patricia Abadesco attended a law enforcement training in Oakland about high risk youth which is similar to our program.

- E. **Crime Data Analysis – Public Health Institute – Capt. Kevin Finnerty**

- The process of accessing data for programs is a (4) step process which we are currently in the first step of. This data which will help identify criminal activity will be available within a couple of weeks.

- F. **Strategic Planning and Program Implementation – Tony Acosta**

- Director Acosta met with Stewart Wakeling and Ronda Jackson regarding obtaining at risk youth referrals from parolees and the court system.
