

Summer Camp Preview:**2010 Summer Day Camp**

Offers children ages 3-16 an opportunity to enjoy a traditional summer day camp experience which includes a variety of fun activities, arts-n-crafts, games, sports, drama, hiking, and nature activities. Each week offers a different theme, recreational swimming, and a special field trip. Camps are held primarily outdoors. Field trip and recreational swimming costs are included in the weekly registration fee. Each camper will receive 1 Day Camp T-shirt. Extended care hours are also available.

CAMP POLLIWOG • Ages 3-5½

Allow your preschooler to experience a traditional “day camp” during the summer. Young campers will enjoy traditional recreational activities in a safe and secure environment.

Each day will be filled with games, crafts, cooking, and sports, as well as occasional fieldtrips. Campers must bring a lunch and snack each day, as well as a blanket and small pillow. We maintain a 1:6 ratio during camp hours.

CAMP HEDGEHOG • Ages 5½*-8

Camp Hedgehog is for children between the ages of 5½*-8 years. This program offers a traditional day camp experience with age appropriate activities and field trips in a nurturing environment.

Camp Hedgehog maintains a 1:8 leader to camper ratio during camp hours. The camp is located at Old Alvarado/Cesar Chavez Park on Smith Street (behind the Union City Historical Museum.)

* Campers MUST have completed kindergarten to attend this program.

KIDS SPORTS CAMP • AGES 5½*-8

This camp is an introduction to sports for younger campers.

This outdoor camp will focus on developing coordination, exercise habits, and an understanding of basic rules. This non-competitive, instructional camp is a great opportunity for youth to learn athletic fundamentals while having fun. Kids Sports Camp maintains a 1:8 leader to camper ratio during camp hours.

SPORTS CAMP • Ages 8-12

The Sports Day Camp is a combination of field trips, special sports events and a variety of instruction in both traditional and non-traditional sports. Activities such as recreational swimming, bowling, sports and sportsmanship instruction will be offered every week. Summer Sports Camp maintains a 1:10 leader to camper ratio during camp hours.

MARSH HAWK DAY CAMP • Ages 8-12

Marsh Hawk Day Camp is for children between the ages of 8-12 years. This program offers campers an energetic outdoor experience through traditional recreational activities, in addition to special events, environmental education, day and overnight field trips. Activities and trips are designed to engage older children who are seeking a change in childcare environments. A ratio of 1:10 leader to campers is maintained during camp hours. Marsh Hawk is located at William Cann Neighborhood Park on Marsh Hawk Road (between Hop Ranch Road and Dowe Avenue).

SUMMER DISCOVER CAMP • Ages 7-12

Summer Discover Camp invites children to discover the vast and diverse world around them through camp! Weekly themes and fieldtrips will encourage learning and adventure through games, art, performing arts, music and science in an exciting and dynamic environment. Discover Camp maintains a 1:10 leader to camper ratio during camp hours.

REC-N-CREW TEEN CAMP • Ages 11½*-16 years

Don't sit around and be bored this summer - do something fun! Join your fellow teens at the UCLS REC-n-Crew Teen Camp! Open to teens between 11½*-16 years. The Rec-n-Crew will be on the go all summer long – including daily field trips, swimming, games, crafts, cooking, sports and weekly community service projects! Camp will meet each day at the Teen Center, located at 1200 “J” Street (in Kennedy Park, behind Logan High School.)

* Campers MUST have completed 6th grade to attend this program.

SUMMER SKATE PROGRAM

Hours: 12:00-5:00 pm • Ages 6-14

The Skate Program will provide instruction in basic skills, safety, balance, etiquette and carving techniques. The program will be a half day from 12:00 pm- 5:00 pm. It will also include trips to local skate parks, swimming, fun activities and participation in two major field trips along with the day camps. Participants must bring their own bag lunch, sunblock, a helmet, elbow and kneepads and skateboard. In-line skates are allowed, although no instruction will be provided. Register early in order to avoid any cancellations. A minimum of 8 participants are required.

For all camps, there is a \$25 per camper, per week fee for any transfers and/or withdrawals. Any changes must be made at least 1 week prior to the camp week which you would like to withdraw or transfer from. Notice of less than 1 week will result in the forfeiture of that week's registration fee.
