On 08/10/10, Detective Steve Cesaretti learned of an attempted murder that occurred in Union City. The detective was able to corroborate the report by locating the victim who was in the Intensive Care Unit at St. Rose Hospital in Hayward. The victim suffered multiple blunt trauma wounds to his head and is still on and off life support and unable to communicate with police.

Through official police channels and follow-up investigation leads were developed. Based on the information received it appears the victim and suspect were involved in a battery on Mission Boulevard near F Street. At the conclusion of the battery, the suspect fled to a residence on the 33500 block of 2nd Street in Union City. The victim followed the suspect to that residence where the victim was jumped by three suspects who punched, kicked and struck the victim multiple times in the head with a blunt object.

The suspects who were identified were Jeffrey Montoya Sr. (07/26/64) and Jeffrey Montoya Jr. (08/18/88). A search warrant and arrest warrant were authored and served resulting in the arrest of both Jeffrey Montoya Sr. and Jeffrey Montoya Jr. Jeffrey Montoya Sr. and Jr. are currently being charged with attempted murder.

There is still one outstanding suspect. The description of the outstanding suspect is a Hispanic Male Adult, approximately 20 years old, with dark hair.
